INFORMATION REQUESTED

1. What is the official policy of the PCC on their individual police forces failing to police illegal hunts properly and take appropriate action when information of and presented with evidence of assault and intimidation?
2. If the PCC does not hold the information requested in my original email, does it hold any information on any subject relating to the performance of their individual police forces. If so, could I please have details of the type of information held.
3. An answer to question 5 in my original email below please. This is a direct question on PCC policy.

RESPONSE

Under S 1 (1) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), I can confirm that the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does not hold the information you have requested.

1. This question relates to alleged failings to police illegal hunts and therefore this information would not be held by the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner. Any alleged failures by the Police Force would be dealt with by Nottinghamshire Police.

The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act continues to protect the operational independence of the police by making it clear that the Chief Constable retains direction and control of the force, officers and staff.
