3. What law allows the use of these camera van/s?

4. What legislation (Act or Statute) authorises the use of these camera vans and collection of vehicle keepers details in terms Data Protection -under the data protection act 2018?

5. How much revenue did Nottinghamshire police collect in 2022 via these mobile camera vans?
