Thank you for your request for information, received by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner Nottinghamshire on 23rd October 2023.

INFORMATION REQUESTED

1. The total number of XL Bully dogs seized under Section 1 of the Dangerous Dogs Act.
2. The number of these dogs that were seized under Section 3, specifically those deemed dangerous or out of control.
3. Of the dogs seized, how many were assessed and subsequently determined not to be a banned breed.
4. Among the dogs deemed not a banned breed, how many were returned to their respective owners. If any of the dogs were not returned to their owners, I would appreciate information on their subsequent outcome.
