breach the principles of the Data Protection Act 2018. We believe that providing you with the information would breach the following Data Protection principles:

- Data shall be fairly, lawfully, and transparently processed
- Data shall be collected for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes and not further processed in a manner that is incompatible with those purposes

We are applying this exemption because:

- a) we do not have the consent of the person who is the subject of the information to disclose it to you;
- disclosure does not meet any of the Article 6 or 9 conditions that would make it "necessary";
- c) disclosure of the information to you would not be connected to the purpose for which we have collected and are holding the information.

We further believe that the release of the requested information would cause unwarranted interference to the rights and freedoms and legitimate interests of the data subject. Such a disclosure would in our view constitute a breach of Article 8 in the Human Rights Act (the right to privacy and family life).

This is our refusal notice in respect of that aspect of your request.
