INFORMATION REQUESTED

Will you please provide me with the total cost of running the Police and Crime Commissioners office. Will you also advice me the cost of running the Police Authority in its last year of existence.

RESPONSE

Under S 1 (1) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), I can confirm that the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does hold the information you have requested.

Please find below answers to your questions:-

2012-13

Police Authority set a budget of £1,228,600 for 2012-13. The Actual spend came in at £1,131,105. A saving of £97,295.

2013-14

The first budget set by the PCC was £1,126,000 still £102,600 less than the last budget of the Police Authority.

Next year the office budget will be slightly larger (£1,135,400) as two new part-time posts will be advertised and filled, but still within the £1.1m range.
