Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2011 Local Audit & Accountability Act 2014

The Police and Crime Commissioner Group Accounts and the Chief Constables Accounts are subject to external audit by Andrew Cardoza of KPMG, One Snowhill, Snow Hill Queensway, Birmingham, B4 6GH. Members of the public and local government electors have certain rights in the audit process:

- 1. From 6th July 2015 to 31st August 2015, between 8:30am to 12:30pm and 1:30pm to 5:00pm Monday to Thursday and to 4:30pm on Friday (except on bank holidays) any person may on application inspect the accounts of the Commissioner and Chief Constable for the year ended 31st March 2015 and certain related documents (comprising books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts) at the Police Headquarters, Sherwood Lodge, Arnold, Nottingham NG5 8PP (telephone 101- Finance). They may also make copies of the accounts and documents.
- 2. From 10:00am on 3rd August 2015 until the conclusion of the audit process, a local government elector (or representative) of Nottinghamshire may ask the auditor questions about the accounts. Please contact the auditor at the address given above to make arrangements to ask any questions.
- 3. From 10:00am on 3rd August 2015 until the conclusion of the audit process, a local government elector (or representative) of Nottinghamshire may object to the Commissioners and Chief Constables accounts asking the auditor to issue a report in the public interest and/or apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law. Written notice of a proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and copied to me at the address given below.
