TITLE: Digital Interview Recorders for Voluntary Attendance (VA) Suites

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

To replace the failing old cassette deck machines currently utilised within the VA Suites with new networked digital interview recording equipment.

## INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (e.g. report or business case)

Currently all VA Suites across the Force are operating using cassette deck interview recording machines, this is old technology and the equipment is regularly failing to either record the full interview or not working at all, with several VA Suites now either out of commission or relying on contemporaneous written records of interview with officers becoming reluctant to rely on the remaining VA facilities for fear of the interview machines failing to record.

The use of VA is a key element of the Forces business models under the Delivering the Future (DTF) Agenda, with close links to the new Response Model, therefore modern and reliable technology is essential in order to continue to use the VA process and also to enable the organisation to increase its use as anticipated within the DTF plans. A capital funding request for £100,000 is required to implement digital interview recording machines with networked capability to fully digitise existing processes, removing the requirement for the storage and management of tapes/CDs and improving Information Assurance/Data Protection.
