Two Police Misconduct Hearings took place on the 3-9 December 2015 and 7 January 2016.

On the 9 December 2015 and 7 January 2016 the Chair of the meeting requested that independent members worked outside of normal working hours to finalise the decision and communicate the outcome to all parties. 
