EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

It will have practical and mechanical skills that are no longer taught in schools facilitating mobility for young volunteers at public events; through the use of bikes once rebuilding is completed. It will have improved road safety and cycle safety through the use of the bikes in a cycling proficiency based scheme (upon satisfactory maintenance and repair of the bikes) that ensure that the pool bikes can only be used by those judged safe to use them through undertaking of the required safety training.

- The Explorer Scout unit currently supports itself by receiving charitable donations in return for supplying young people to act as stewards at events such as the Lowdham RHS gala, Robin Hood Marathon and other local events where they manage car parks, keep overnight watch on erected marquees and act as points of contact to the public and the use of the bicycles (once they had been made safe and repaired) was intended to improve their ability to cover what can be large areas therefore further benefits are:-
- Beneficial service to the local community through the young people in turn serving as capable guardians at local events and providing community benefits through provision of services to improve their local environment (clearing footpaths, delivering shopping, building facilities etc).
- Good will and insight into the Force for the young people through contact with the Force.
