TITLE: Refurbishment and Conversion of the Northern Control Room (Mansfield) into three IT Training Rooms with alternative use as back-up Force Control Room

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

In January 2019, Nottinghamshire Police submitted a Business Case to develop the Sherwood Lodge HQ site to be a new shared HQ with Nottinghamshire Fire and Rescue Service and to include the Force Training School Provision.

The anticipated capital spend associated with this project of £18,500,000 has been approved by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner and design work has commenced.

Within the Approved Business Case with Section 8 – Interdependencies said:

Command and Control Project

The Command and Control Project is presently working to deliver a replacement Command and Control System within both the Northern and Force Control Rooms and this is due to go live in January 2020, which is almost 18 months before the new Force Control Room is likely to be commissioned.

It is also a requirement of this project that EMCHRS(L+D) have access to 5 IT training rooms for the force. Work is taking place to understand the cost associated with adapting the Northern Control Room to be used both as a 'Dark Site / Reserve Control Room and 3 IT training classrooms.

This would require an additional capital cost, the relocation of existing staff working from the Northern Control Room and sequencing with the roll out of the Safe Command and Control System in the Northern Control Room.

There will also need to be consideration as to deploying new desks and desktop hardware into the new control room or moving the 18 month old equipment from the existing control room.

In approving the Business case the need to re-develop the Northern Control Room was also approved, however, at that time the outline design and anticipated cost was not known. The Chief Officer Team have confirmed that a further decision is not required and that the capital request should be considered by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner.

The purpose of this report is to confirm the cost associated with delivering the conversion to the Northern Control Room and to seek an increase in the capital budget to enable the delivery of the project.

This work will ensure that the force has the required number of IT training classrooms to meet business need and it will ensure that Business Continuity can be maintained in the event that there is a failure of the Sherwood Lodge Control Room.

A review of the critical path for the HQ Project and the Command and Control Project has identified that the works will commence in January 2020 with completion by the 31st March 2020.
