EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Nottingham and Nottinghamshire Violence Reduction Unit (VRU) wishes to undertake some research to explore the impact of experiencing or witnessing violence on boys' beliefs and behaviours in Nottingham and Nottinghamshire. A Request for Proposals was sent to four organisations for a response which detailed that up to £10,000 funding was available for this work.

Only one organisation responded to the Request for Proposals. This bid was evaluated by a panel with the Bid being deemed as compliant and awardable. The panel did however ask that a few amendments be made to the delivery plan which resulted in a slightly increased cost for delivery of this research.

The Commissioner is therefore requested to approve that the research contract be awarded to Nottingham Trent University at a total cost of £12,032.

INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)

Nottingham VRU wishes to commission some research which will explore the beliefs and behaviours of boys who have witnessed and/or experienced domestic violence (including sexual violence in the home environment), to gain an understanding of their beliefs and behaviours in relation to violence directed towards women and girls. The focus for the research is on boys aged 10-18 years.

The key priority for the research is that the engagement will provide recommendations that guide the VRUs action planning and commissioning. The specification was not prescriptive and the VRU anticipated the engagement could use a variety of methodologies to gather the insight on boys' beliefs and behaviours, including desktop research, engagement with boys and young men, working with organisations providing support to boys; and/or adopting a wider sampling strategy such as surveys on understanding perceptions and beliefs. A place based approach was encouraged, to explore the different experiences boys may have in different parts of the city and county.

A Request for Proposals including a specification for the research was developed and circulated to four potential organisations to respond. This Request for Proposals detailed that up to £10,000 was available for this work. This is in line with Contract Standing Orders, which requires only 1 quote for activity up to £10,000 and 3 quotes for activity up to £25,000.

Only one organisation responded. This bid was evaluated by a panel with the bid being deemed compliant and awardable. The panel did however ask that a few amendments be made to the delivery

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plan to ensure that it represented the views of boys across both the city and county which resulted in a slightly increased cost for delivery of the research.

The research will therefore be undertaken by Nottingham Trent University at a total cost of £12,032. Given that the price increased to over the £10,000 as was detailed in the Request for Proposals this contract will be awarded as a single tender award. The reason for this being that only one organisation responded to the initial Request for Proposals and there was not time to re-issue the Request for Proposals with a higher price cap.
