INFORMATION REQUESTED

1. Source of information on which the documented reduction (under heading "Fact File") in various crime has been calculate.
2. How much of the indicated reduction has been estimated to be due to the national reduction in crime due to the national "lockdown" over the past 12 months.
3. The costs associated with the production and issue of the 4 page pamphlet issued through the council tax mail shot.

RESPONSE

1. The data was sourced from the Police Daily Crime and Performance database.
2. The data is based on actual crime data not estimates although the data may be subject to minor changes following the validation process. Similar reductions have been experienced in other Police areas. There is no data held by the OPCC that provides any insight to explain the impact of COVID restrictions on crime reductions.
