Notification on Publication of Police & Crime Commissioner & Group Statement of Accounts for 2022/23

The publication of the draft statement of accounts for the year ended 31 March 2023 has been delayed as the audit of the statement of accounts for the previous years ending 31 March 2021 and 31 March 2022 have not yet been completed by our external auditors, Ernst & Young LLP due to late finalisation of the 2019/20 financial statements. This is because of resourcing issues and recruitment challenges.

The expectation is that the draft accounts will be published by 31st October 2023.

Notification on Audit of Police & Crime Commissioner & Group Statement of Accounts for 2022/23

The external audit of the draft statement of accounts for the year ended 31 March 2023 has not yet been completed by our external auditors, EY LLP, due to the complex set of factors contributing to audit delays across the sector. This situation is allowed for by Regulation 10, paragraph (2a) of the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015.
