The Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner will support the Police and Crime Commissioner to deliver the policing and crime plan priorities.

I have appointed Chris Cutland as the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner for Nottinghamshire.

I have set out below Chris' professional experience for her new role:

- She has received public recognition for her work last year. She was one of a 100 women of substance in Nottingham City and runner up for the enterprise women of the year awarded by Derbyshire and Nottinghamshire Chamber of Commerce.
- Chief Executive of Women's Aid Integrated Services for over seven years. This involved the management of a large service and budgets.
- Previous working of working with senior elected officials, including MPs and other key decision makers
- Long history of partnership working with Nottinghamshire Police for over 20 years.

The Police and Crime Panel unanimously supported the appointment of Chris Cutland as the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner.
