TITLE: Funding for UK Network of Sex Work Projects for Ugly Mugs initiative

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Ugly Mugs initiative encourages sex workers to sign up to receive warnings about dangerous individuals reported by other sex workers. Details are passed on anonymously to the police with consent. It's run by the UK Network of Sex Work Projects, which is a non-profit, voluntary association of agencies and individuals working with sex workers. The project received Home Office funding during 2012-3 to run the scheme as a pilot. No further funding was available from the Home Office.

INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (e.g report or business case)

Following advice and information from officers in Nottinghamshire Police, who thought the Ugly Mugs service essential, the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner and Chief Executive verbally agreed in January 2014 to support the Ugly Mugs national initiative by providing £3,000 funding during 2013-4 and again in 2014-5. Funding was conditional on receipt of satisfactory grant application forms.

Grant application forms for 2013-4 and 2014-5 were received and approved.
