**TITLE:** Night time levy (Train the Trainer Licence)

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

To seek approval for spending of Late Night Levy monies for a three year 'Train the Trainer' Licence Agreement with Drinkaware in relation to Nightlife Crew.

**INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (e.g report or business case)**

Nottingham CDP and the OPCC worked closely with Drinkaware to successfully pilot 'Club Hosts'. Now Nightlife Crew, these trained staff work in clubs and venues across Nottingham to support the welfare and well-being of young people on a night out. Crew work in pairs and mingle with customers to promote a positive social atmosphere and help those who may be vulnerable as a result of drinking too much alcohol. This includes reuniting people with their friends, helping people into taxis or emotional support.

The Late Night Levy has previously been used to fund Drinkaware Nightlife Crew training and eLearning. This has made a significant impact in terms of increased awareness of safety issues and support for vulnerable people in the night time economy.

Due to high staff turnover in terms of bar and security staff in the ENTE, it would be more effective and economical to build our own capacity and capability for training.

This is a highly specialised area with very few (if any) other suppliers. Drinkaware has experience and expertise at a national level and is Home Office and industry approved. The alternatives, purchasing further training or developing in-house provision would be more expensive and less sustainable.

The cost of the projects are as follows:

Year 1 (£9,000): A one day train the trainer course for up to 15 people, one day's quality assurance, one day marketing support, access to e-learning and training licence.

Year 2 (£3,000) One day's quality assurance, one day marketing support, access to e-learning and training licence.

Year 3 (£3,000) as Year 2.

This relates to revenue expenditure and would be within budget for the Night Time Levy.
