**TITLE: Award of Contracts to Delivery County Domestic Abuse Support 2020-8**

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

As outlined in Notice of Decision 2019.025, the PCC agreed to co-commission domestic abuse support services in the county with Nottinghamshire County Council, with the County Council acting as the lead commissioner under the umbrella of an Inter Authority Agreement.

An invitation to tender was published in September 2019. The tender was a framework agreement which included 3 lots:

- Lot 1: Support Services in South Nottinghamshire
- Lot 2: Support Services in North Nottinghamshire
- Lot 3: Provision of Prevention, Promotion and Training

One bid was received for each lot. Each bid was evaluated by a panel of County Council and OPCC staff, with each meeting the quality and financial thresholds.

The PCC is requested to approve:

1. The award of the Support Service in South Nottinghamshire call off contract to Juno Women's Aid, with a value of £580k pa, of which £202,922.50 is funded by the PCC's Victims' Services Grant. The contract will run for 4 years from 1 April 2020, with options to extend for a further 4 years;
2. The award of the Support Services in North Nottinghamshire call off contract to Nottinghamshire Women's Aid with a value of £580k pa, of which £202,922.50 is funded by the PCC's Victims' Services Grant. The contract will run for 4 years from 1 April 2020, with options to extend for a further 4 years;
3. The award of the Provision of Prevention, Promotion and Training call off contract to Equation, with a value of £20,000 pa, of which the PCC will fund £10,000 from his Community Safety Grant. The contract will run for 4 years from 1 April 2020, with options to extend for a further 4 years.

#### **INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (e.g report or business case)**

The procurement was managed by the County Council on behalf of the County and the PCC.

The procurement involved establishing a single provider framework agreement, divided into three Lots, to cover the County of Nottinghamshire (excluding Nottingham City), using an open procedure in accordance with the Light Touch Regime of the Public Contract Regulations 2015.

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A new Inter Authority Agreement will be developed to set out the legal framework for the co-commissioning arrangements.
