TITLE: New Adult Sexual Assault Referral Centre (ASARC)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Office of the Police Crime Commissioner (OPCC), National Health Service England (NHSE) and Nottinghamshire Police have worked together to review the current provision of Sexual Assault Referral Centre (SARC) services in Nottinghamshire and to identify the changes required to provide a better standard of victim care and an improved standard of forensic evidence as required in forthcoming accreditation standards.

The current adult SARC (Topaz Centre) was assessed as being unsuitable for future use when assessed against operational need and forthcoming forensic accreditation requirements. There is no scope for extending the building, nor the opportunity (which has been extensively explored), for co-locating and integrating support services to provide a seamless support package for victims. In addition, and from a justice perspective more critical, the Topaz Centre is in need of reparation and improvement from a forensic standard perspective. This required urgent mitigation works in 2017 at cost of £20,000, with significant further expenditure required to try to bring the building up to United Kingdom Accreditation Standards (UKAS) forensic standards.

The proposal is to construct a new SARC building which will provide a purpose built, high quality facility, meeting both UKAS forensic standards and user/operational requirements. This will enable the provision of an improved standard of victim care in addition to an improved standard of forensic evidence. The building will also provide a high standard of environmental credentials.

OPCC Observation on Business Case

The Force's business case confirms that the force has no policing operational reason to keep the existing TOPAZ centre and it is recommended that the building is sold to offset the cost of the SARC new building. The wider victim services system is currently under review and this review has highlighted some opportunities and accommodation risks. In consultation with the Police and Crime Commissioner the Chief Executive has agreed that the existing TOPAZ building is not sold for now. The new SARC presents an enormous opportunity to build a facility that is fit for purpose and is sustainable into the future. The final foot print and size of the building needs to meet all stakeholder requirements. The recommendations have been amended to reflect this change.

The capital cost of designing and constructing the new SARC building is estimated to be in the region of £1,600,000. Taking into account a contribution from NHS England, the net capital cost to the Police is estimated at £1,300,000.

The current Topaz Centre is estimated to have a revenue cost of £98,200 per annum, comprising building running costs and forensic consumables, IT and furnishings. The new build is estimated to have an ongoing revenue cost of £118,000. This uplift of approximately £20,000 is due to an increase in building running costs due to the increased size of the proposed new build.
