EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This decision form provides an outline of division of funding by the Crime and Drugs Partnership (CDP) during 2021/22

INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (e.g report or business case)

The CDP was allocated £160,000 of funding by the OPCC in 2021/22 to fund activity in line with CDP priorities.

An agreement was made by the OPCC, CDP and VRU in 2020 that whilst funding decisions would continue to be made by the City Council, in consultation with the VRU and OPCC, that this funding would be administered by the Violence Reduction Unit (VRU) to enable monitoring of projects alongside VRU commissioned interventions.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

It is proposed that the £160,000 allocated to the CDP is disseminated to the following organisations.
