EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This decision form seeks approval of a Single Tender Waiver in order to directly award £36,600 to Powell and Barnes Media for the provision of the #stopviolence social media campaign and development of the HashtagNG website.

See below the proposal for the continuation of funding for the #stopviolence social media campaign and development and maintenance of the HashtagNG website which was approved by the Strategic Violence Reduction Board on 11th March 2021. £36,600 of the VRU budget has been allocated for the provision which was signed off as part of an earlier Notice of Decision ref.2021.031.

The campaign has been a success locally and nationally, having reached 142,000 young people in Nottinghamshire and receiving a national award. Much of this success is down to the involvement of young people in co-producing the campaign, this is a credit to the Provider who has spent time building relationships with young people in the communities most impacted. A Single Tender Waiver is proposed in order to maintain consistency of service for the next 12 months in terms of the production, look and feel.

Background

Powell and Barnes Media won the initial contract for the development and implementation of social media campaign and website following an open tender process in November 2019. The contract value was £37,204 and was funded from the Early Intervention Youth Fund. Since then two further Grants have been awarded by the VRU, totalling £26059.50, for the continuation of the campaign and website during 2020/21.
