EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The PCC has been approached by a number of organisations requesting financial assistance in 2022-23. Up to £5,000 is being sought to support the 2022 Black Achievers Awards event in Nottingham and a financial contribution towards its work for road crime victims in Nottinghamshire is being sought by Brake.

The PCC is therefore requested to confirm her approval to use 2022/23 Community Safety Grant to:

- Award up to £5,000 to PATRA to support the 2022 Black Achievers Awards; and
- Award up to £1,000 to Brake for the continuing provision of their bereavement information packs to be provided to families in Nottinghamshire.

INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)

The Black Achievers Awards aims to bring together people from all walks of Nottingham and Nottinghamshire to recognise and promote the achievements of our BME community. The PCC has agreed to be the Headline Sponsor for the event in October and as such will be featured in the publicity material associated with the event. There will also be an opportunity on the night to interact with the public and other stakeholders enabling engagement and relationship building with BME leaders.

Promoting and celebrating the success of the BME community in Nottinghamshire will help to create a better understanding amongst the wider community of BME communities and their positive contributions. This is an important element in the building of strong, proud and safe communities – all of which are key priorities for the Police and Crime Commissioner. The awards themselves and the stories behind the winners alongside the inspirational speakers attending on the night will help to inspire others - both old and young – to achieve through the promotion of positive role models.

Brake is a road safety charity working with communities and organisations across the UK to stop the tragedy of road deaths and injuries, make streets and communities safer for everyone, and

support people bereaved and seriously injured on roads. Brake provide the National Road Victim Service (NRVS) which works with those who are bereaved and/or suffering the most serios life changing injuries due to road crime. They provide NRVS bereavement packs for the police to distribute to all bereaved families. Funding to enable this to continue in 2022/23 will be provided by the PCC.
