TITLE: Decision Making Policy

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This Policy applies to decision-making by the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) and those exercising delegated authority on behalf of the PCC. It details the arrangements put in place to enable the PCC to make well-informed and transparent decisions that are robust to public scrutiny.

This Policy also seeks to provide information to assist the Police and Crime Panel in its role in scrutinising the decisions and actions of the PCC.

Some decisions will be complex by their very nature and decisions have different impacts (e.g., from local to national). This sliding scale of decision-making will demand a related and proportionate scale in terms of the amount of information, advice, support, challenge, scrutiny and consultation given in advance of, and following, the decision. Decisions will range from single, internally-focussed, low impact decisions through to those of significant public interest, consequences and cost.
