EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Violence Reduction Unit (VRU) seek approval of spend to fund a pilot for Pupil and Parent Engagement at Stone Soup Alternative Provision

INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)

The VRU wish to commission a proof of concept project which will be delivered at the Stone Soup Academy, alternative provision. The intervention will provide targeted support to children and young people who have known risk factors associated with serious violence and poor attendance record; an additional staff member will provide dedicated 121 support to a small cohort, engaging closely with parents and other agencies to whom the beneficiary may be known. The intervention is expected to start in January 2023 ending in December 2023 and will be subject to independent evaluation.

Stone Soup already have a number of workshops running with girls to support them with healthy relationships outside of school including knife crime and gangs. They are also looking at the Equation AP programme.

Stone Soup are linked in with Street Doctors, Enactus and the University of Nottingham, Dreams, and Youth Justice and this year will be completing their third annual Stand up to Knife Crime. These activities are for both boys and girls at the academy.

It is anticipated that the proposed pilot project for pupil and parent engagement will complement their existing offers and provide an enhanced robust approach with families.

Funding for this pilot will be a total of £34,000 with £8,500 being spent in 2022/23 and £25,500 being spent in 2023/24. Please note the funding will require a Single Tender Award, the rationale being that this is a pilot to inform future commissioning.
