### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This notice of decision relates to a £10,000 grant which will be awarded to the Nottingham CYF project for the completion of the film 'Hollow'. This is a community led initiative that uses film and lived experience to tackle concerns in relation to serious violence and exploitation. It will be funded from the VRP budget.

### INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)

A grant of £10,000 is to be awarded to Nottingham CYF to fund:

- Final edit and colour grade
- National online screening to include a panel of speakers, including experts in child criminal exploitation and care experienced children and young people
- Local screenings for children and young people in APs and youth work settings
- Social media distribution

#### Aims/objectives:<sup>[1]</sup><sub>[SEP]</sub>

- Raise awareness of themes tackled within the film at a national level to influence national and local policy to ensure children and young people are supported to be diverted from violence and criminal exploitation.
- Divert first time youth offenders away from the criminal justice system with a specific focus on young people who are on the periphery of gang related offending.<sup>[1]</sup><sub>[SEP]</sub>
- Young people will develop an understanding of: the long and short term risks and implications of criminal exploitation; how to safely exit gangs and where and how to access support and access positive alternative opportunities and pathways designed to appeal to this specific target group.<sup>[1]</sup><sub>[SEP]</sub>
