#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The PCC intends to issue a grant to the Majority Black Led Churches (MBLC) committee to run two co-produced community workshops aimed at raising greater awareness of local community cultural experiences in the police and build trust and confidence in the police in black communities. The attendance will be approximately 100 people at each event and will predominately engage those from Black communities, with opportunities to share experiences as well as hearing from keynote speakers on topics such as the race action plan and community cohesion. A report and recommendations will be produced to provide insight in to support ongoing work and engagement.

## **INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION:** (eg report or business case)

Force performance on retention of Black and Minority Ethnic Community employees is poor with research into the force from NTU recommending ongoing engagement with the BME community as method of improvement (Ngonyani et al, 2018). The Police Race Action Plan outlines the need for meaningful involvement of Black communities and their voice in policing. Using a community led mode of consultation as opposed to police/OPCC will help to overcome trust deficit issues which traditionally exist between the police and the Black Community (Lammy Review 2018). This will create access to a greater range of voices from different demographics, producing more legitimate and accurate feedback to inform the work of the PCC.

#### FINANCIAL INFORMATION

£2.5k funding from the 2022/23 grants and commissioning budget and £2,500 from the 2023/24 PCC grants and commissioning budget for workshops in each respective financial year. Funding will go to God's Vineyard Ministries who are the charity financially accountable for activities of the MBLC.
