EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This decision form seeks approval to award £6414.48 to Nottingham Business Improvement District for the provision of safe space pledge audits. Funding is to be granted from the Late Night Levy fund.

INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)

As part of the remaining late-night levy / SWAN funding the working group discussed the appetite to expand a twice-yearly audit of safe space pledge venues to assess awareness and training needs. This will re-enforce the safe pledge and ensure continued growth with businesses around the need to develop safe working practices ensuring it is embedded within the signed-up businesses.

The audit will be undertaken by Business Liaison Officers, working for the Nottingham Business Improvement District, and is expected to cover 151 venues.

The timescales for the delivery of this activity are expected to be February 2023 – March 2024.
