TITLE: OPCC Caseworker system – award of contract

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The PCC is requested to approve the award of a contract to Elected Technologies for provision of the Caseworker Gov system for OPCC casework and correspondence at a total cost of up to £7,400 from 1st April 2023 to 31st March 2026.

These costs are broken down as:

- 3-year annual hosting fee and support for up to 10 licences: £5,400
- Discovery, set up and configuration charge: £1,500
- Training sessions: £500

INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)

As an elected official, the Police and Crime Commissioner is responsible for overseeing the police force. As a result of this, the Office for the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) receives a large number of correspondence and casework from members of the public.

The current caseworker system used is out of date and not fit for purpose. Caseworker Gov is utilised by a number of OPCCs nationally. It provides a simple way to track and access all OPCC casework and correspondence.
