<b>TITLE:</b>	2023/24 PCC Grants to Nottingham Crime and Drugs Partnership (CDP) and Safer Nottinghamshire Board (SNB)
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### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The PCC is requested to confirm her approval to make the following grant awards to Nottingham Crime and Drugs Partnership (CDP) and the Safer Nottinghamshire Board (SNB):

Nottingham Crime and Drugs Partnership (CDP):

- Up to £40,000 will be allocated to the CDP as a contribution towards CDP staffing.
- Up to £35,000 will be made available for Serious Violence / Youth Crime Prevention Work in Nottingham City (Qrts 1 & 2). This £35,000 will be distributed to three third sector providers. Funding agreements will be put in place directly between the PCC and each individual organisation.

Safer Nottinghamshire Board (SNB):

- Up to £109,000 will be allocated to the County Council for Youth Crime Prevention.
- Up to £200,000 will be allocated for Locality funding. This £200,000 will be distributed amongst the seven district councils following submission of a business case to the PCC. Funding agreements will be put in place directly between the PCC and each of the seven district councils.

All this funding will come from the PCCs 2023/24 grants and commissioning budget.

### INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)

In previous years the PCC has awarded community safety grants to Nottingham Crime and Drugs Partnership (CDP) and the Safer Nottinghamshire Board (SNB) as key partners for the PCC. The grants will fund work to deliver initiatives to achieve the strategic goals in the Nottinghamshire Police and Crime Plan.

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In relation to the £35,000 for Serious Violence / Youth Crime prevention work in Nottingham City it has been agreed this will be distributed as follows via direct grant agreements from the PCC:

- £12,500 to African Caribbean Asian Forum (via Nottingham Equal) for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023 to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2023 for the provision of their project Passages.
- £12,500 to Community Recording Studios for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023 to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2023 for the provision of their project CRS.
- £10,000 to Take One Studios for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023 to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2023 for the provision of their project Keeping it Real Mentor.

During the six months of delivery these projects will be assessed for their effectiveness.

### FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The funding requested is revenue and will all come from the PCCs 2023/24 grants and commissioning budget. Grant funding will be provided and actual costs only will be funded.
