#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The Violence Reduction Partnership (VRP) seek approval of spend to fund / contribute to the following partnership events to support the prevention and early intervention agenda:

- Contribution to Nottinghamshire Police's Kick Off @ 3 Event £1000
- Positively Empowered Kids Festival £1200

### **INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION:** (eg report or business case)

#### Kick Off @ 3 Event - £1000

Following the success of the 2022 event, where over 200 young people took part, a further Kick Off @3 tournament has been arranged across 2 days on 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> June 2023 at Clifton. Nottinghamshire Police, in partnership with NET trams, Nottingham College, University of Nottingham, Nottinghamshire Fire and Rescue, and the Royal Air Force, have arranged a football tournament between police officers and children and young people in the city that will enable positive interactions and the building of trusting relationships in a familiar environment. This year's event has been expanded to include a younger age group 11-12 and girls' groups.

Participants will also be able to engage with partners, including the VRP, hosting stalls to provide signposting and relevant information, including opportunities about further education, apprenticeships, employability and other support. The £1000 will contribute to facilitation and marketing of the event.

### Positively Empowered Kids (PEK) Festival - £1200

The PEK Festival will take place on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> July 23 at Nottingham Racecourse. This contribution toward the event will enable vulnerable children from families with multiple disadvantages, where costs may otherwise be prohibitive, to attend the PEK Festival which provides activities to promote positive mental health and wellbeing. The

festival will also facilitate information stands in which the VRP will participate alongside agencies from across the partnership including CAMHS and Head to Head. This promotion and signposting will promote accessibility into for those communities who may not typically seek and get support.

Funding totals £1600 to be drawn from 2022/23 carry forward reserves and £600 from the PCC
