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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Further to DR 2023.048 which detailed that £35,000 was allocated for Serious Violence Crime prevention work in Nottingham City during the period 1st April 2023 to 30th September 2023, the PCC is requested to confirm a further £35,000 to be distributed amongst the three serious violence crime prevention projects to deliver initiatives from 1st October 2023 to 31st March 2024.

INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)

In relation to the £35,000 for Serious Violence prevention work in Nottingham City it has been agreed this will be distributed as follows via direct grant agreements from the PCC:

- £12,500 to African Caribbean Asian Forum (via Nottingham Equal) for the period 1st October 2023 to 31st March 2024 for the provision of their project Passages.
- £12,500 to Community Recording Studios for the period 1st October 2023 to 31st March 2024 for the provision of their project CRS.
- £10,000 to Take One Studios for the period 1st October 2023 to 31st March 2024 for the provision of their project Keeping it Real Mentor.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The funding requested is revenue and will all come from the PCCs 2023/24 grants and commissioning budget. Grant funding will be provided, and actual costs only will be funded.
