### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Commissioner is seeking a provider to Establish and oversee a new ASB Immediate Justice Adult Reparation Scheme.

A Request for Proposals was disseminated to **six** organisations. One bid was received and following an evaluation of this bid, Red Snapper managed services has been selected.

The total value of the contract is estimated to be no more than **£50,000** for the duration of the contract, including any potential call off work throughout the duration of the contract.

The PCC is therefore requested to approve the award of a contract to Red Snapper Managed Services to establish a new ASB Immediate Justice Adult Reparation Scheme total cost of £50,000 from 20<sup>th</sup> October 2023 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024.

### INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)

Nottinghamshire has been chosen by the Home Office as a "trailblazer" for a scheme to bring "swift and visible justice" to perpetrators of antisocial behaviour. Tackling antisocial behaviour is a key priority within the Commissioner's Make Notts Safe (Police and Crime) Plan.

Nottinghamshire, including Nottingham city, is one of 16 Police and Crime Commissioner areas that will receive significant funding to clamp down on these types of crimes as part of the Government's Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) Action Plan.


Under the pilot, Nottinghamshire will trial a new "immediate justice" scheme, where offenders currently subject to Police Out of Court disposals found committing crimes of an antisocial behaviour nature (criminal damage, arson, drug possession, public order offences, and possible others to be added) will be required to undertake unpaid community work with an ambition for them to start work as soon as 48 hours after referral to the placement activity of the new ASB Immediate Justice Reparation Scheme so victims know antisocial behaviour is treated seriously and with urgency. We will work with local partners to explore ways in which other types of ASB can be routed into the referral process.


During the process the standing order regulations were reduced to £25,000 however as this process had already stated the Chief Finance Officer agreed to allow us to continue under the previous standing order regulations set at £50,000 to avoid a delay in securing a provider.
