### MY ELECTION PLEDGES FOR REDUCING CRIME

I have already set the wheels turning on my election promises. They will, however, continue to be a pivotal part of my plans for achieving safer communities.

### My pledges are to:

- Campaign against Government funding cuts to our policing budget
- Improve Community Policing by taking on 150 extra Police Officers and 100 Police Community Safety Officers
- Work in partnership to reduce antisocial behaviour by 50%
- Give extra priority and resources to domestic violence and crimes against girls and women
- Ensure that victims of crime are treated as people, not cases, and that Victim Support is properly funded
